Option 1

Write a 1000-1200 word essay to compare the key features of Australia's system of government with ONE other system of government in the Asia region (such as Indonesia, China or India). Include an analysis of the values that underpin these key features.

Option 2

Present a 5-8 minute speech to compare the key features of Australia's system of government with ONE other system of government in the Asia region (such as Indonesia, China or India). Include an analysis of the values that underline these key features.

Option 3

Present a creative response to compare the key features and values of Australia's system of government with ONE other system of government in the Asia region (such as Indonesia, China or India). Your creative response could take the form of an artwork, video or animation. Check your response form with your teacher before you begin. Include a 300-400 word rationale for your creative response. Describe how your response compares the key features and values of Australia's system of government with the other system you chose.
